In the Wassenaar/Hague area, BAM has built the junction for the future RW14 trunk road and the N44 as part of a programme designed to make The Hague more accessible. Previously, the N44 was at ground level with a viaduct taking the Northern ring road over it. The only links between the two roads were the branches that connected up with the road parallel to the N44. Because this led to dangerous situations and congestion, a completely new layout for the intersection was designed.

The N44 now runs through a depressed track, while the RW14 through-traffic goes over the junction on a viaduct. Traffic turning off is distributed at ground level, which helps to improve safety and ensure good traffic flow. A particular problem during this project was the fact that the new junction ended up in virtually the same place as the old one, while traffic on both roads had to be kept flowing at all times.
